## **Struktur der Ausstellung als Modell und Pilotprojekt.**

Ausgangspunkt wird der menschliche Leib und sein Körper sein.

Von den Haar-Spitzen bis zu den Zehen-Spitzen werden die Glieder, die leiblichen, wachsenden, fließenden Teile und Oberflächen untersucht, die als Material in diversen Performances genutzt werden.

In der Ausstellung werden die Materialien an die Wände gebracht und in Leserichtung von Kopf bis Fuss geführt.

Wir werden keine digitalen Geräte, keine elektronischen Equipments nutzen, denn dies übersteigt das Modell.

## **Wir bitten um die Zusendung folgender Materialien:**

Texte - Beschreibungen der Performances die das gesendete Material beinhaltet

Texte - Philosophische und theoretische Reflexionen über die Wahl des Materials, (bis A3)

Photographien, (minimal 13x18cm bis A4), Listen und Diagramme werden Hauptbestandteil der Ausstellung sein. Relikte von Performances werden auch Bestand der Ausstellung sein.

1 - Folgend nun die die Bereiche, Glieder und Oberflächen des Leibes und ihre Erweiterungen nach Innen, nach Außen und Eigenfunktionen

2 - An Hand des Materials Haare werden wir hier aufzeigen, was gesucht und was von uns erwünscht ist - mit der Hoffnung, dies zu gesendet zu bekommen.

## **Structure of the exhibition as model and pilot project**

The human body and the corpus will be the starting point.

From the roots of the hair to the tip of the toes all parts of the body will be examined, like those parts which are bodily, growing and fluent parts and surfaces which are used as materials in various performances.

The material, we receive, will be placed on the walls and continued then in direction of all walls – from head to feed.

We don't use digital devices, nor equipments. This exceeds the model of this exhibition.

## **We ask for participation and we beg for sending your material:**

Text - descriptions of the Performances in which this material was used

Text - philosophical and theoretical reflections over the choice of the matter. (max format A3)

Furthermore photographs (minimal 13x18cm; max format A4).

Lists, diagrams will be the continuative components of the show. Relics of Performances will be also parts of the presentation.

A list of all participating artists will exhibit too

1 – Following now the context of the body with all categories of its parts – limbs, skin, organs, liquids, functions, etc.

2 – on the basis of the material **hair** we demonstrate the context of research with hope, to get clear display to exhibit.

A three dimension contextual and grammatical exhibition about used material in Performance and Performance Art. The spectrum moves from natural material, produced material, over thoughts, statements, ideas, to cultural and social theories

**The presentation will take place May, June 2013**

We, Boris Nieslony and Sibylle Ettengruber, are preparing an exhibition at Künstlervereinigung Maerz (Linz/Austria), taking a contextual look on performance art and performance and interaction in public space by designing it visual.

A walk-in diagramm with different constallations and relations is going to be built with the big hope to fulfill that experiment. We ask lots of different Performance artists and artists working in public space to participate by sending us expressive material of their work.

The visual connection of the material is immanent and is going to be prepared in a diagrammatic way. (view attached pictures of the exhibition model and the link to Performance Art context below)

What material are we asking for?

Text, handwritten notes, prints, photocopies, sketches, notations, etc. (max size A3)

and/or Photos (13x18cm, 18x24cm, DinA4 + A3, color or bw, etc)

Poster, flyer (max DinA3)

and/or Objects can be part of the material, e.g. as a relict, parts of installations, etc. The size of the area is not to be bigger than A3, if it is in a larger scale and reasonable, we will operate economically.

All material received is going to be diagrammatically and contextually installed by Sibylle Ettengruber and Boris Nieslony. Placed in the situation.

Basic points in the textual relation are going to be: philosophy, society, anthropology, ethnology, and mental activity in any shape, (Art) History, etc

Visual is any picture, content, atmosphere, symbol, sign, etc which is part of the artistical action or in public space and shows a relation to an activity or an action.

In addition we ask for a visual complement to your selected material concerning your performance art and your artistic activity and refering to your influences and the diversity of contexts of your daily life to expands that view.

Anthropological and ethnographical views on public (with political and social appearance and historical relations) as well as things, matter, material ( physically, academically, theoretically) and artefacts and products are important. (maximum size 40x40x40cm)

We ask to send the material as a hardcopy and not in a digital way. Lots of things can be selected as an addition by us using the internet, but it is indispensable for you to select your material on your own and to be an entire part of the diagrammatic picture with your name as co-author as well.
